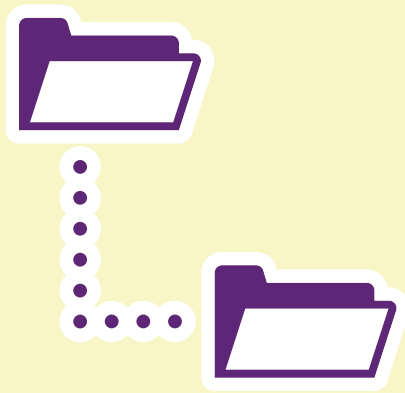
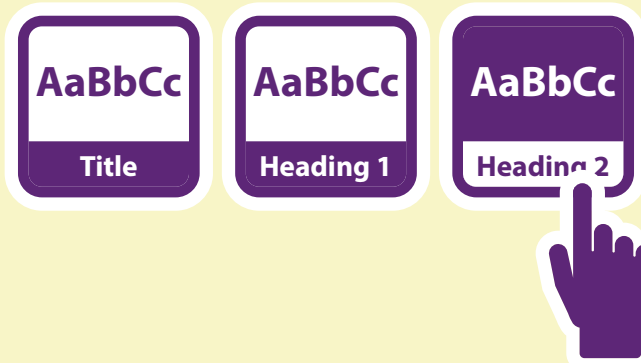


UK Accessibility Regulations: 9 key things to consider



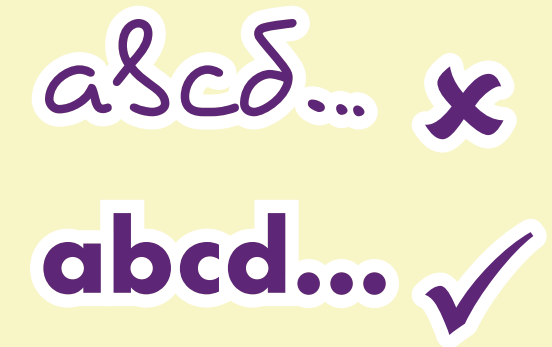
1 ORGANISE

Organise your module clearly. Use simple language and avoid using coloured text or tabs.



2 STRUCTURE

Always use heading styles e.g. Title, h1, h2, when creating new course or module documents.



3 DESIGN

Use high contrast colours and clear fonts in presentations and documents.



4 DESCRIBE

Add alternative text (Alt Text) descriptions to all your images.



5 PROVIDE

Where possible give students editable course documents.



6 CAPTION

It is a legal requirement to add captions to all your recordings. Some tools can do this automatically.



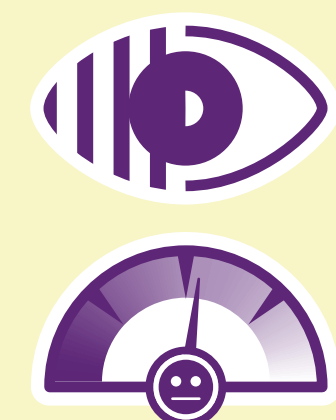
7 LINK

Use descriptive wording for all your hyperlinked text.



8 SELECT

Select appropriate Unilearn tools for your course or module and use them consistently.



9 CHECK

Check and improve the accessibility of your course material using Blackboard Ally or Office 365.
